## Job Description:

You will need an intimate grasp of the science behind cannabis medicines - the isolated and synergistic interactions of cannabinoids and terpenes in the body - as well as a more applied understanding of the production and manufacturing of cannabis medicines: strains, extraction techniques, delivery devices, bioavailability etc.

- Identify the most promising production method based on scientific and market research: whole plant extracts, isolated compounds, additional botanicals, etc.

- Interact with Beckley's partners in the cannabis space
- Work closely with the Director in planning new scientific studies on cannabis and cannabinoids
